PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

To the Honorable the JOSEPH WILLOUGHBY hereby filed, respectfully shew:

(1) My place of residence is 1845 7th Ave., New York, NY My occupation is building attendant
(2) I was born in Port of Spain, Trinidad, B.W.I. December 27, 1896 My race is African Black
(3) I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on March 5, 1936 in the U.S. District
Court of Southern District at New York, NY
(4) I am married. The name of my wife is Petronilla
we were married on August 22, 1922 at New York, NY
born at Curacao, B.W.I. on December 7, 1895 entered the United States
at New York, NY on January 1917 for permanent residence therein, and now
resides at 1845 7th Ave., New York, NY I have 3 children, and the name, date,
and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children are as follows: Regina, March 23, 1923; Rita,
July 16, 1924; Joseph, November 21, 1928. All born at New York, NY. All reside
at New York, NY.

(6) My last foreign residence was Port of Spain, Trinidad, B.W.I. I emigrated to the United States of
America from Port of Spain, Trinidad, B.W.I. My lawful entry for permanent residence in the United States
was at New York, NY under the name of Joseph Willoughby Willoughby
on June 30, 1919 on the vessel Mayaro
as shown by the certificate of my arrival attached hereto.

(7) I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed
to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States
and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the United States. It is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and
forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to

George VI by the Grace of God, of Great Britain, Ireland and the British
Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith, and Supreme Governor of the Commonwealth of England, Scotland and Town of Berwick upon Tyne
(8) I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since
June 30, 1919 and in the County of New York
this State, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since June 30, 1919 being a residence within said county of at least
six months next preceding the date of this petition.

(10) I have not heretofore made petition for Naturalization Number _____ on _____
at _____ and such petition was denied by that Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit:
_____ and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed.

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition for citizenship, are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States, certificate from the
