Her name was Amanda Willoughby and she was the daughter of William M. Willoughby (1860-1893) and Melinda June Bratcher (1863-1893), both of Butler County, Kentucky. William was the son of Isaac (1834-1865), the son of James H. (1802-c.1870), the son of Isaac (born N.Carolina c. 1750-c.1850) who was last seen in the District 14 Jackson County, Tennessee Federal Census at the ripe old age of 100! In 1896 Amanda married William Lonzo Evans in Butler Co., Kentucky and had four children. The family moved to Eldorado, Saline County, Illinois about 1919 where there they lived out their days with the exception of Jacova "Cova" who is buried somewhere in Chicago. Cova had Ruth Evans Wright who had my mother, Linda. My sweet, sweet Mother and delightful Grandmother Ruth lived in an extended family situation with "Mama & Pop Evans" and their daughter, Opal, for many years. Mother (still living in Eldorado) says Mama Evans was one of the sweetest women to ever grace the earth and has many fond stories to tell of her. She knew virtually nothing, though, of Amanda's family and life in Kentucky which is why I began our family research with the Willoughby name.
