Old Salem Church is seceded from Presbyterian Church; it is on the pike from Knoxville to Sevierville, and on the old Elijah Dunn farm (no building there now).

Martha B. Cowan McCammon, Nov., 1815-Nov. 4, 1876.

James Wilson, Nov. 8, 1841-Dec. 19, 1848. He was a member of the seceded church. His son-in-law was Marsh Walker; no issue. Another son-in-law was J. H. Giffin; no issue; also William Houser, John Harvey King, and Wm. Reed, son of Lewis Aprangler. He had a daughter to marry a Dunn; her name was Vina Caroline Wilson Dunn; he died, and she married Columbus Gamble. William Wilson married a Ford. Capt. Joseph Wilson of the police force of Knoxville is a descendant of Wm. Wilson.

This cemetery was often called the McCammon Cemetery.
