Willoughby, John R., Private: Enlisted in Bertie County on August 9, 1862. Present or accounted for through October 1864, being reported as absent without leave from September 1, 1862, through April 1863, and from August 1863 through October 1, 1864. During this period, he enlisted (June 22, 1863) in Company E, First Regiment North Carolina Union Volunteers, at Plymouth, NC. Deserted from the Federal army at Newport Barracks, NC, on July 14, 1864, and rejoined this company. Records show that he was issued clothing on October 20, 1864. No further records found.

Willoughby, John W., Private: Enlisted in Bertie County on August 9, 1862, at the age of 30. Reported as a deserter on company muster rolls from May-June, 1863, through August 1864. Appears as present on muster roll for September-October, 1864. Admitted to hospital at Raleigh, NC, on February 3, 1865, with typhoid fever and returned to duty on March 11, 1865.

Willoughby, Winborn, Private: Enlisted in Bertie County on August 9, 1862, at the age of 26. Present or accounted for through October 1864, date of last available muster roll.
