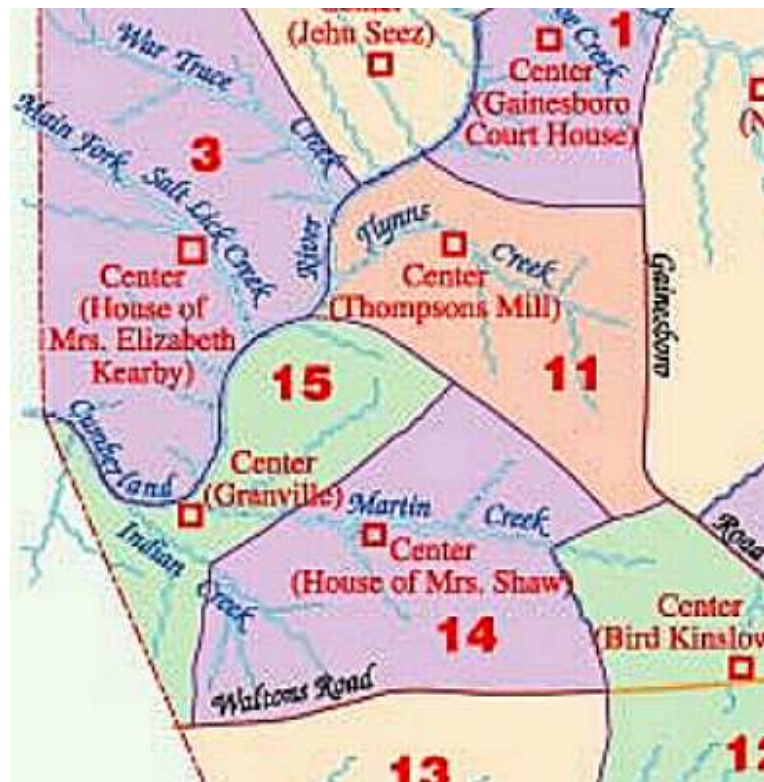
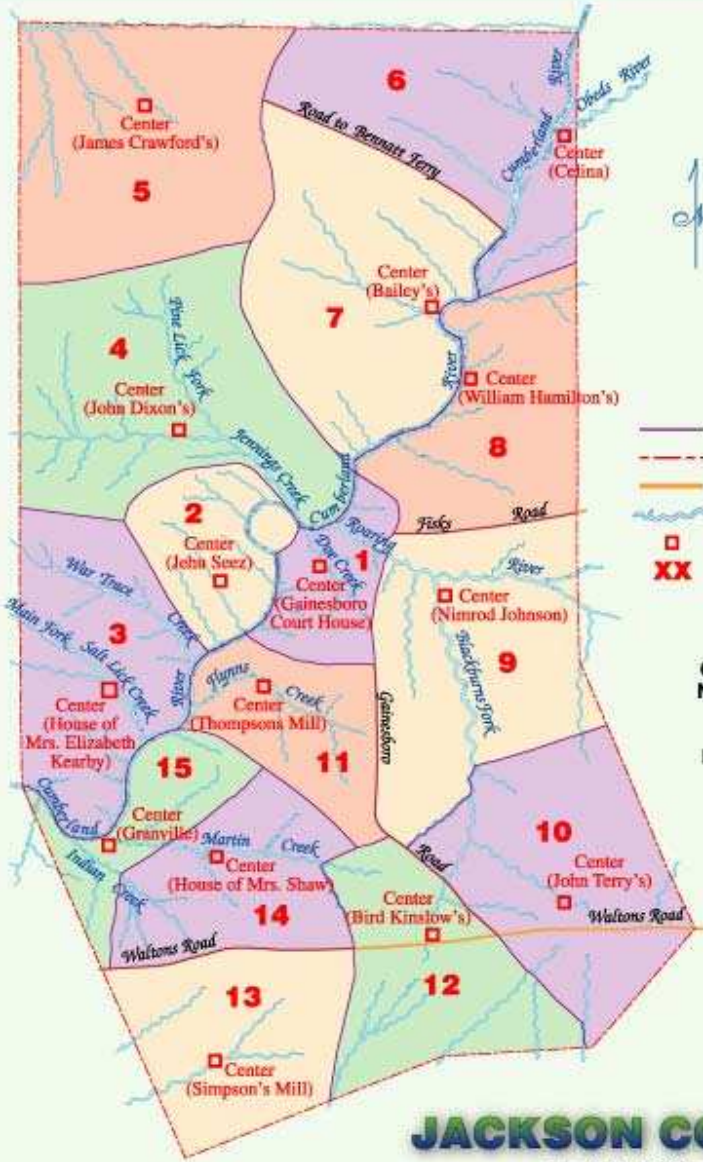


The Fourteenth District: 1836

The 14th District beginning at **William Carr** on the Walton Road which is a corner for the 13th District turns thence down **Harpers** fork of **Martins** Creek to the junction with **Goolsby's** fork thence up the point with the dividing ridge between the said **Goolsbys** fork and the west fork of **Flynns** Creek to **Shepherds** Road on the ridge thence with said road to near the head of the Dry fork of **Martins** Creek thence along the extreme top of the ridge between the Dry fork and main fork of **Martins** Creek to the head of the branch which mouths into James (missing paper?) Mill pond between **Henry Sadlers** and **Leonard Huffs** thence a direct course to the main fork of **Martins'** Creek at the upper end of **Henry Sadlers** plantation thence crossing the creek at the upper end of **Rollins Hogans** plantation thence a direct course to the main fork of Indian Creek at the upper end of the Widow **Holfords** plantation thence crossing the creek at the upper end of **Garret Sadlers** plantation thence west to the top of the ridge between the main fork and **Dillard's** Fork of Indian Creek thence along the extreme top of the ridge between said forks and **Apples** fork and **Dillard's** fork to the Walton Road thence with the Walton Road to the beginning within which bounds the election shall be held at the house of Mrs. **Shaw** at the mouth of **Shaws** Branch.
