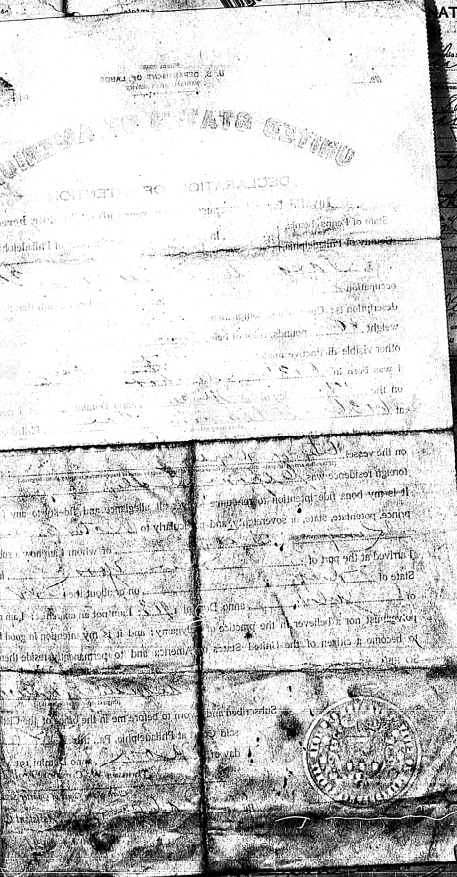
ORDER OF COURT ADMITTING PETITIONER
