I have been married to *Elizabeth* on the *15* day of *Jan* anno Domini *1907* at *Whitstable England*

I have no other children, and the names of said place of birth and place of residence of each of said children is as follows:

I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching dissent to or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to permanently reside within the United States of America.

I can speak the English language.

I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least, immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the *15* day of *Mar* anno Domini *1902* at *Philadelphia, Pa.* and I have been a resident within the State of Pennsylvania, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the *15* day of *Mar* anno Domini *1907* at *Philadelphia, Pa.*

I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court, Federal or State, and I have not been a citizen of the United States of America.

I have not been sentenced by the said Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit:

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the certificate from the Department of Labor, together with my affidavit and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses therein, required by law. Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.
