Biography of Francis George Godfrey Willoughby (1890-1915)

Francis was the third son of the [10th Baron Middleton](#) . Born at Settrington, Yorkshire, he was educated at Cheam School and Wellington College before entering Trinity College, Cambridge. He intended a career in the Diplomatic corps, but on the outbreak of war in 1914 he entered the 9th Battalion The Rifle Brigade. He was killed in Flanders on 9th August 1915.
