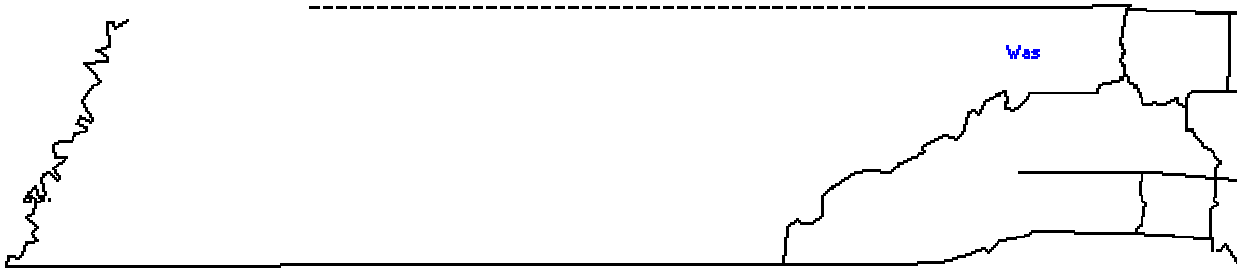


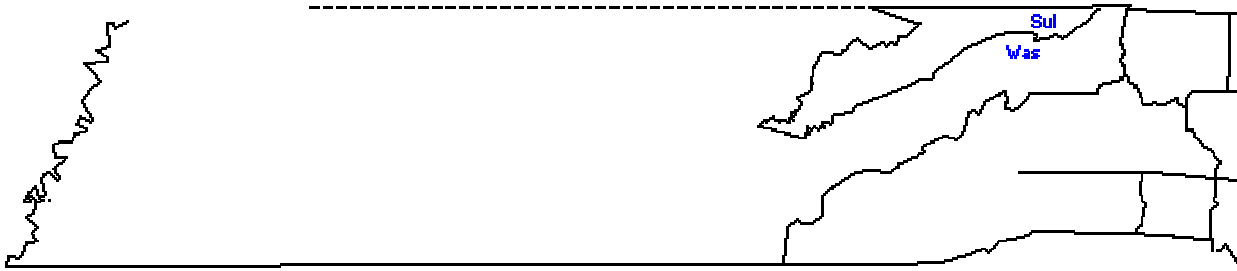

Previously Washington District, created in 1776.



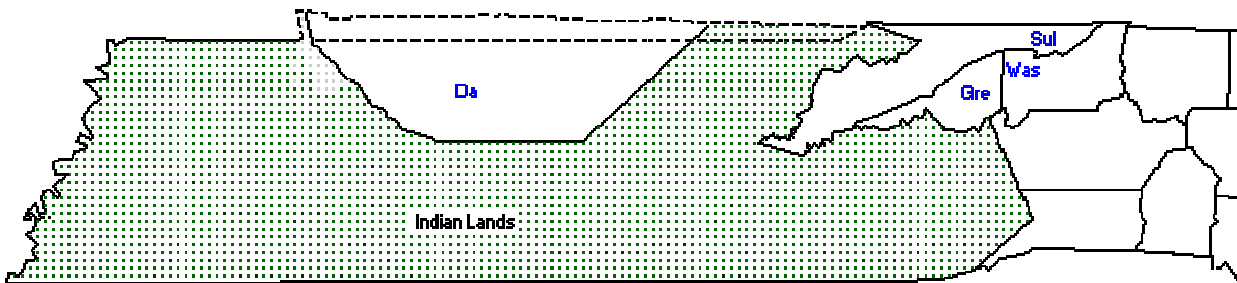

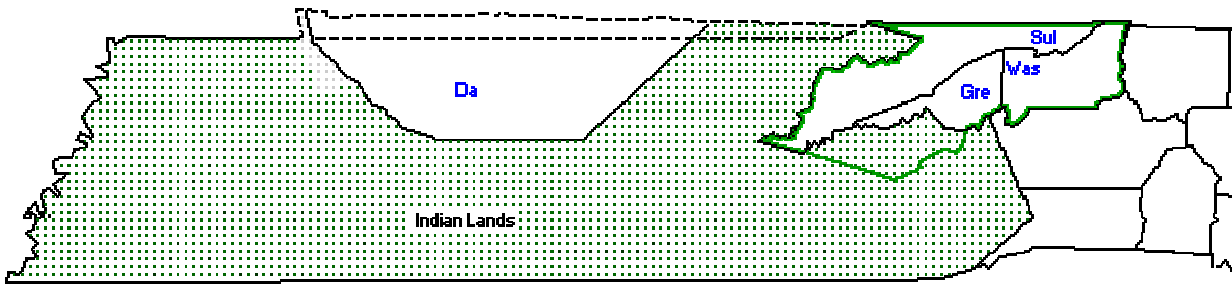

Western part of Virginia boundary surveyed 1779-80.



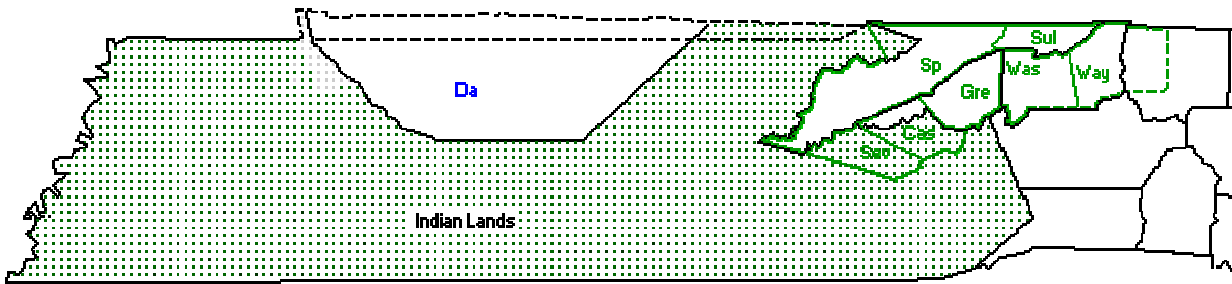

Three eastern counties, Washington, Sullivan and Greene, form provisional state of Franklin in move to secede from North Carolina.



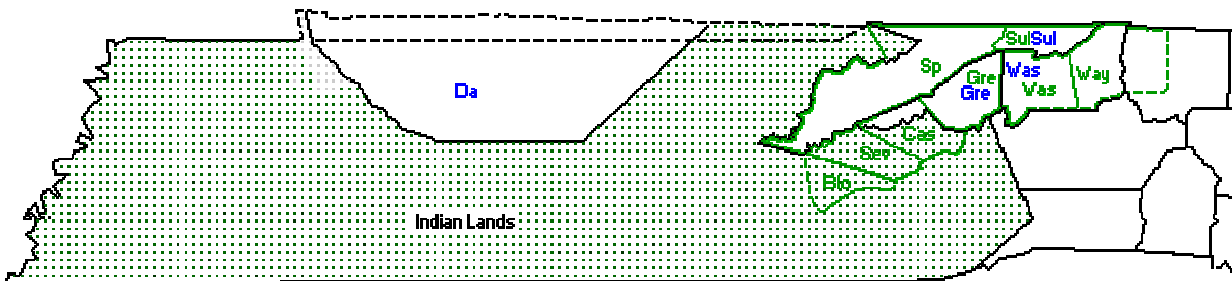

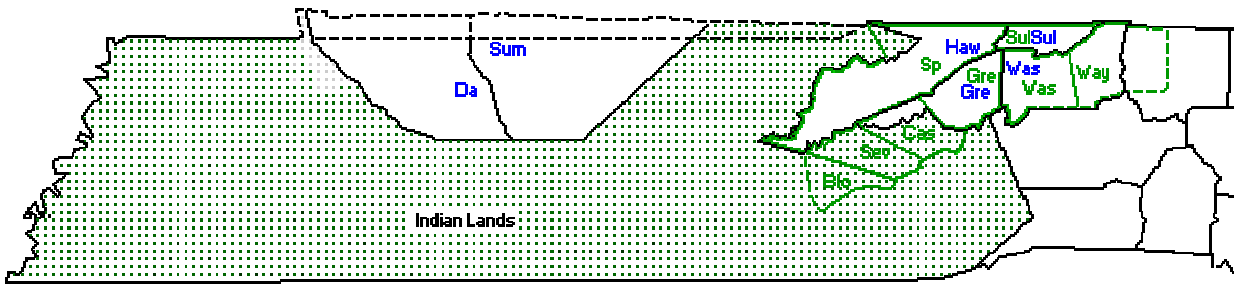

Blount created by State of Franklin. North Carolina reconstitutes its governments for Washington, Sullivan and Greene, which function in parallel with Franklin's in those counties.



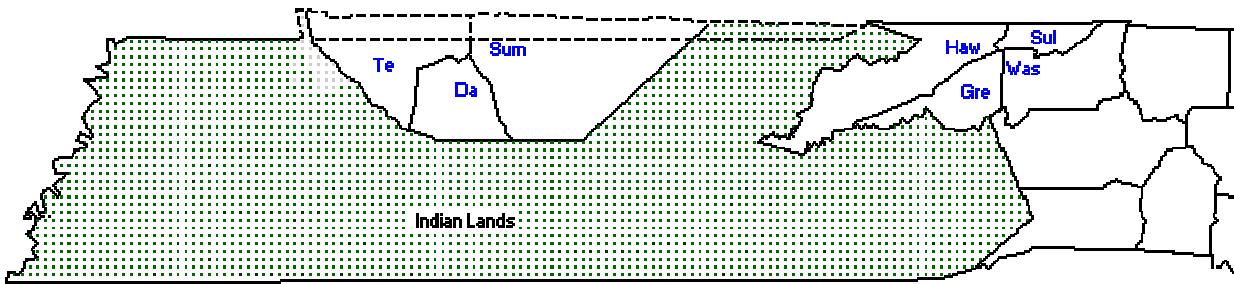

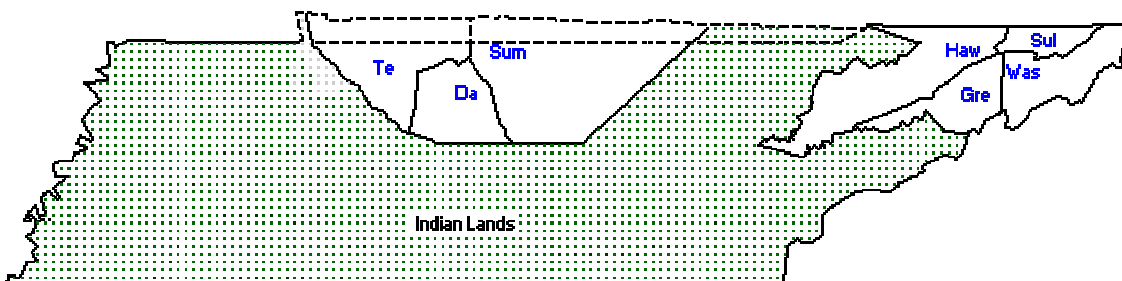

Tennessee from Davidson. State of Franklin and its counties cease to function.



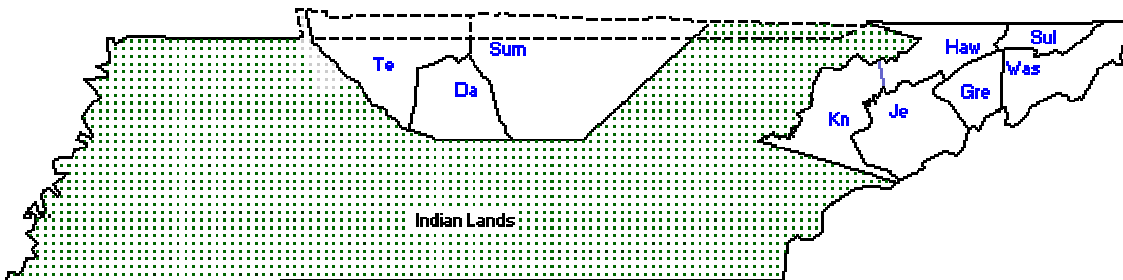

North Carolina cedes western region, organized as Territory South of the Ohio River.



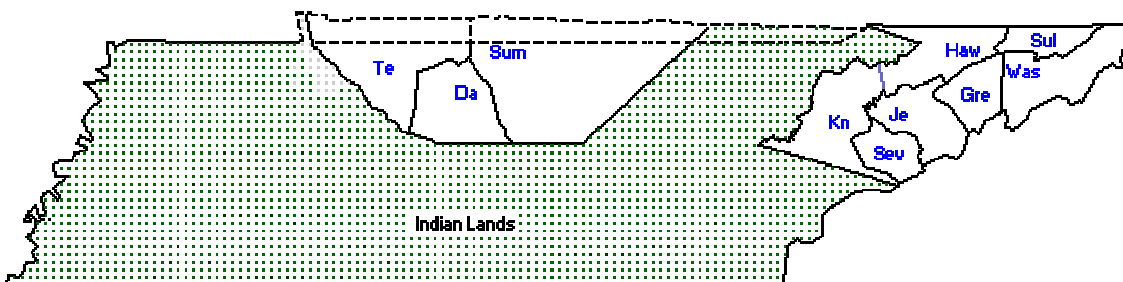
