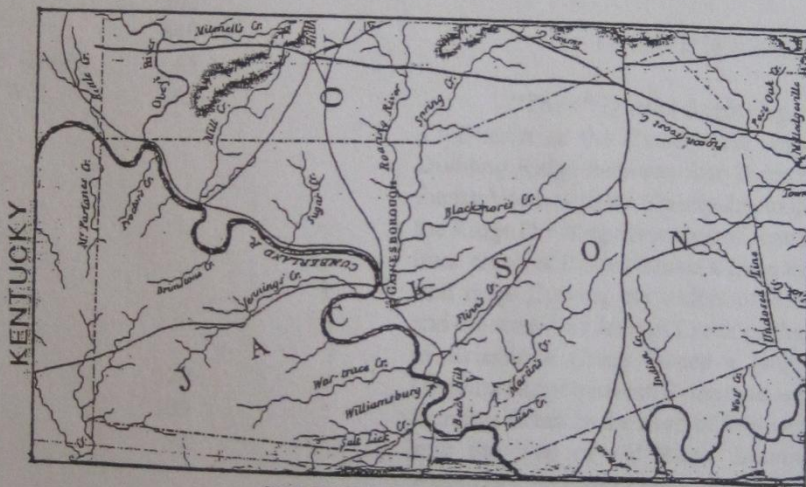

FIFTEENTH DISTRICT

"15th The Boundary of the 15th District shall Be as follows to wit - Beginning on the south Bank of Cumberland River just above the Mouth of the Big Branch opposite to old Williams Burgh runs thence up the Bluff to the Top of the Ridge Between the Big Branch & the Branch which runs in at Williams Ferry thence along the Extreme top of the ridge Between the waters of Flyn's Creek on the East and the Big Branch on the west to the head of the Dry fork of Martins Creek thence along the Extreme Top fo the Ridge Between the Dry fork and the Main fork of Martins Creek to the head

of the Branch which Mouths into Roberts Mill pond Between henry Sadlers and Leonard Huffs thence a direct line to the Main Martins Creek at the upper End of Henry Sadlers plantation thence Crossing the Creek and leaving the plantation of Rawlins Hogans on the West thence a Direct line to the Main fork of Indian Creek at the upper End of the Widow Holfords plantation thence Crossing the Creek & leaving the plantation of Garrett Sadler on the North thence west to the Top of the Ridge Between the Main fork and the west fork of Indian Creek thence along the Extreme top of the Ridge Between said forks and Apples fork and Dillard's fork to the walton road thence with said Road to the Smith County line thence with the Smith County line to Cumberland River thence a cross the River to the Point opposite the upper side of the Mouth of Dry Branch thence along the Extreme hight of the Ridge between the Dry Branch & John Morelands Branch to the head of s'd Branchs thence a Long the Extreme hight of the Ridge leaving the waters of the Branches on which Thomas Burton[,] Henry holomon[,] & Col. James Holomons Lives on the south and the Branches runing through the old Ruffin plantation & on which George W. Clark lives on the North, to Cumberland River opposite to the upper End of Joseph Williamsons plantation thence Crossing the River & up the same with its Meanders to the Beginning the Election to be held in said Bounds of Granville."
